### DEPARTMENT OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

The Department of International Relations was established on September 5, 1995. The year 2000 was marked by the first graduation ceremony of specialists in the field.

In 2000 the specialty of International Relations was accredited and in 2006 and 2018 it was re-accredited. In 2003, the Master's studies were opened within the Department, and in 2005 the Doctoral studies were introduced.

Starting with 2005, the training of specialists in international relations is carried out in accordance with the standards of the Bologna Process. Since 2016, the form of distance learning has been organized. At the moment, the training process is provided by over 30 teachers, among which:

- ◆ **6 Doctors Habilitatus of Sciences, Full Professors;**
- ◆ **6 PhDs, Associate Professors;**
- ◆ **3 PhDs, Assistant Professors;**
- ◆ **5 Teaching Assistants or Assistant Professors, masters, PhD students.**

## Language of instruction: Romanian or Russian

The specialization in Diplomatic Studies is a master degree, provided for the deepening of knowledge in the field of diplomatic theory and practice.

The program comprises: fundamental subjects (5), specialization (11), specialization practice and master thesis.

It includes subjects such as:

- Public diplomacy;
- Parliamentary diplomacy: theory and practice;
- Economic Diplomacy;
- Conflict prevention and international crisis management.

The program is aimed at training specialists that possess theoretical, knowledge, analysis and explanatory capabilities of international relations, theoretical and practical skills in the field of diplomatic service and activity in national / international organizations and projects.

Career opportunities for graduates in Diplomatic Studies program:

- ◆ specialist in state-owned structures;
- ◆ civil servant;
- ◆ diplomatic service official;
- ◆ scientific researcher;
- ◆ expert analyst on foreign policy issues and international relations;
- ◆ consultant in international organizations;
- ◆ consultant for international projects / programs.



# European Studies

## Language of instruction: Romanian or Russian and English (in case of forming a group of at least 15 people)

The European Studies Specialization is a master degree, focused on the broad study of European issues and processes. It emphasizes the theory, philosophy and the experience of the European integration.

The program comprises: fundamental subjects (5), specialization (11), specialization practice and master thesis.

It includes the following disciplines:

- Public diplomacy
- The EU in the international relations system;
- Europeanization and EU Enlargement Conditionality;
- Interdisciplinary analysis in European studies;
- European multiculturalism.

The graduates of the European Studies specialty have the opportunity to engage in the following institutions:

- Ministry of Foreign Affairs and European Integration of the Republic of Moldova
- Parliament of the Republic of Moldova
- European Integration Departments of State Institutions of the Republic of Moldova
- NGOs and National and European Projects, as expert and consultant
